Documents Required

- Passport
- Certificate of Enrollment/ Student Status Letter (Provided by home university on official letterhead, confirming you are a current student)
- Academic Transcript (Provided by home university)
- Letter of Recommendation (From appropriate faculty)
- Proof of Finances (Bank Statement)

Language Requirements

- All courses are taught in English, except vernacular literature courses.
- English Requirements: TOEFL iBT 80/ TOEFL PBT 550/ IELTS 6.5/ B2 English Certificate
