Fall (Monsoon) Semester/ full academic year (Aug 2026)	• Nomination deadline: 1st April, 2026 • Application deadline: 31st May, 2026
Spring Semester (Jan 2027)	• Nomination deadline: 30 October, 2026 • Application deadline: 15 November, 2026
Nomination Process	Partner Institution to fill-up details of nominated student/ s through the Online Nomination Form Monsoon 2026
Application	Nominated students should apply once their names are sent to Ashoka University through their international office. Link would be provided directly to the student/ s.

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Admission and Course Registration

Admission process	Step 1 – Email from Office of Global Education along with Application form and Medical & Wellbeing form is sent out to the nominated students Step 2 - Application form and documents are reviewed by the Office of Global Education team, they are called for a quick online interaction Step 3 – After the Online interaction, acceptance offer is sent Step 4 - Once the student accepts the offer, an invoice (for accommodation, meal plan & other costs) is sent. Step 5 - After the payment is received, a final acceptance letter and letter of visa invitation is sent from Ashoka University. <i>Visiting Student Programme (VSP) email ID is generated for incoming students to proceed further and rest of the process takes place</i>
Semester course load	You can choose maximum 5 courses (4 credits each) Each 4-credit course involves 40 contact hours. 1 optional (2 credits) co-curricular course in performing arts/ visual arts/ languages.
Course registration	VSP students can proceed with course registration once their Ashoka VSP email ID is generated in the system. Course catalog is visible to students a month prior to their semester starting date on Ashoka Management System (AMS).

	The Office of Global Education guides students in selecting courses and registering for the same. VSP students can choose courses as per their academic preference and availability. Note - Some courses have prerequisites. Incoming students need to provide evidence of prior knowledge of the topic to receive a waiver on prerequisites.
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Accommodation

Campus accommodation	Ashoka University is a residential university, and all international visiting students are also guaranteed campus accommodation in fully-furnished residence halls with laundry service. Rooms are on a double-occupancy basis. We pair visiting international students with Ashoka students to encourage intercultural exchange. Note - Single room accommodation is not available.
Meal plan	Students receive a meal plan (Breakfast, Lunch, Evening Snacks, Dinner) at the dining facilities of Ashoka. <i>This is included in the fees structure.</i> Note - Campus has additional food outlets, where students can purchase the same at their own cost.
