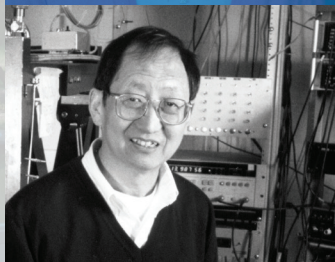

STUDENT AND GRADUATE SUCCESS

Hands-on learning opportunities in the Quad Cities include internships at the world headquarters for **John Deere** and other **Fortune 500** companies such as **ALCOA** and **3M**, and in evolutionary robotics or biochemical research with professors in Augustana laboratories during the summer.

Off-campus internships have included **Disney World**, **Target**, **ESPN**, **Deloitte & Touche—Chicago**, **Chicago Bears**, **Merrill Lynch**, **AT&T Global Accounts**, **Dow Chemical**, **the Field Museum**, **PriceWaterhouseCoopers**, and many more.

90% of business majors complete internships, compared with **75%** nationwide.

Augustana has more than **5 career counselors per 1,000 students**, compared with a national average of 1.5.

Augustana graduates are in careers at **Facebook**, **LinkedIn**, **Google**, the Large Hadron Collider at **CERN** in Geneva, and the **FBI**. They go on to graduate studies at Harvard, Yale, Princeton, Notre Dame and MIT, and to the best professional programs for the business and health fields. Other graduates have been **CEOs** and **CFOs** at **Fortune 500** companies including **Brown-Forman Corporation**, **Pepsi-Cola North America**, and **EQT Corporation**.

AUGUSTANA ACADEMIC FIELDS

A much higher percentage of Augustana students than the national average focus on **two or three majors**, increasing their career options. In 2014, nearly **83%** of the graduating class had more than one major and/or minor.

Accounting, business and engineering are popular majors:

ACCOUNTING

- Augustana students obtain **prestigious internships**, including the highly competitive Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB).
- Most internships lead to **full-time job offers**, many before graduating.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

- Students job shadow with employers in the Quad Cities, home to more than **30,000 businesses**.
- **90%** of Augustana business students complete internships, compared with 75% nationwide.

ENGINEERING

- Students take advantage of Augustana's dual-degree program: 3 years at Augustana followed by 2 years at the engineering school, earning **2 degrees: bachelor of arts and bachelor of science in engineering**.
- Augustana engineering students have guaranteed admission to some prestigious ABET-accredited schools, including **New York's Columbia University**.
