Insurance Requirements	All international students must enroll the national health insurance since March 2021. In year 2023, the monthly health insurance fee is approx KRW 75,490 per month. The premium fee may be changed every year. After registering your residence card in Korea, you will be subject to enroll the national health insurance and the fee invoice will be informed to you from the National Health Insurance Service. If you receive medical coverage equivalent to medical care benefits (Article 41 of the National Health Insurance Act) by foreign laws, from foreign insurance, or under the contract with your employer, you may apply for exemption from the subscription. Please contact NHIS directly regarding your exemption.

Exchange student applicants whose nationalities are non-OECD must additionally

1. Submit the original <Certificate of Enrollment>
2. Submit the original <Bank balance Certificate>

By the Korea immigration office policy strengthening, we are now requiring non-OECD nationality exchange students(D-2-6) document submission for <Letter of acceptance>, since 2022 Fall incoming students.

1. Both documents need to be submitted **both** (1) Online application **AND** (2) hard copies via post.

When the hard copy document is received at Sookmyung, we will be going through the <Letter of acceptance>



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process.

2. Even if the applicant's home university is located in OECD member countries, she/he still needs to submit documents above, according to her/his nationality.
3. We do not have the deadline, however we recommend students to start the process as soon as possible for a swift process. Letter of acceptance will be issued when we receive the electronic copies via your home univ. program coordinator

◆◆◆◆ HOW TO SUBMIT THE DOCUMENT ◆◆◆◆

1. Students need to upload the apostilled/consular certified documents above on the Online application system upon application. Students need to check "NON-OECD" section, and upload the apostilled/consular certified documents.
2. Submit the original copies to your home univ. program coordinator. She/he will send us the original hard copy to Sookmyung via post.
3. Once SMU receive the hard copy, we will be sending the <Letter of acceptance> needed for D-2-6 student visato the student.
