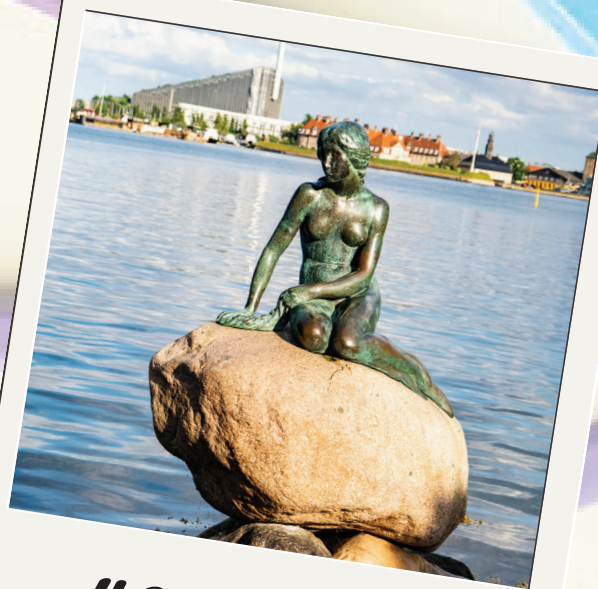

Aalborg University (AAU)

Aalborg University consists of **three campuses** located in **Aalborg** (main campus), **Esbjerg** and **Copenhagen**. On a national basis approximately **18,000 students** are studying at Aalborg University.

Aalborg University - Aalborg Campus

The **main campus** of AAU is located in the northern part of Denmark, in **the 4th largest city, Aalborg**. This campus is our biggest campus with approximately **15,000 students**. This campus offers a wide range of study fields, with **everything from biotechnology to language studies**.



Aalborg University - Copenhagen Campus

AAU CPH is our campus in **the capital of Denmark, Copenhagen**, with approximately **2,600 students**. Situated in **the heart of Copenhagen**, AAU CPH's modern buildings are located right down to the canals and parks. The campus offers education within the **study fields of technology and IT**.



Aalborg University - Esbjerg Campus

AAU Esbjerg can be found on the west coast of Denmark towards the North Sea and is **the 5th largest city in Denmark**. The city of Esbjerg is part of the **"World Energy Cities Partnership"** which attracts many businesses within sustainability. This campus is the smallest of the three campuses with about **400 attending students**. AAU Esbjerg offers **programs focusing on natural science and engineering**.

Living costs and finding a home

As an international student you can apply for a furnished room or apartment in **Aalborg** and **Esbjerg** through the university's **International Accommodation Office**.

AAU Accommodation types

	Dormitory	Private accommodation	Shared accommodation
Description	Single room (private room) with shared facilities (shared kitchen and bathroom) with other students in a dormitory. Contract In **Aalborg** the lease is fixed for 6 months from either 1 February to 1 August or 1 August to 1 February. You pay for three months in advance.

In **Esbjerg** you pay a deposit and the first month's rent in advance hereafter it's paid monthly to the owners of the dormitory.

AAU Copenhagen cannot provide housing, but you can find more information on our website
