REQUIREMENTS AND ACADEMIC CALENDAR

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

A minimum B2 is required for the language in which the chosen course is taught according to CEFR (Language certificate issued by the home institution proving at least B2 English language level).

OTHER

The student must be currently enrolled at the partner institution.

MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM CREDITS

Min. 15, max. 35 ECTS credits per semester.
