Immigration procedures

Most international students from outside the EU/EEA studying in the Netherlands for more than three months, need to apply for an entry visa and/or a Dutch residence permit. After acceptance, students will be informed on all immigration procedures.

Housing

EUR does not provide housing. Students are responsible for arranging their own accommodation. A limited number of rooms is reserved for about 25% of incoming international students. The majority, including most exchange students, will need to find housing on the private market. Our website offers plenty of tips and advice to help students out.

On average, students living and studying in Rotterdam spend between €1.000 and €1.500 per month on essentials like housing, food, insurance, and study materials. Housing and traveling costs during their stay can vary considerably.
