Entry Requirements

- You're currently enrolled at an overseas university, college or higher education institution, and have completed at least one year of study.
- Hold a minimum GPA of at least 2.8 or equivalent. Students who don't meet the minimum requirement may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- If English isn't your first language, you'll need to submit evidence of your English language ability. Our courses typically require an IELTS score of 6.5, but individual programmes may have additional requirements:

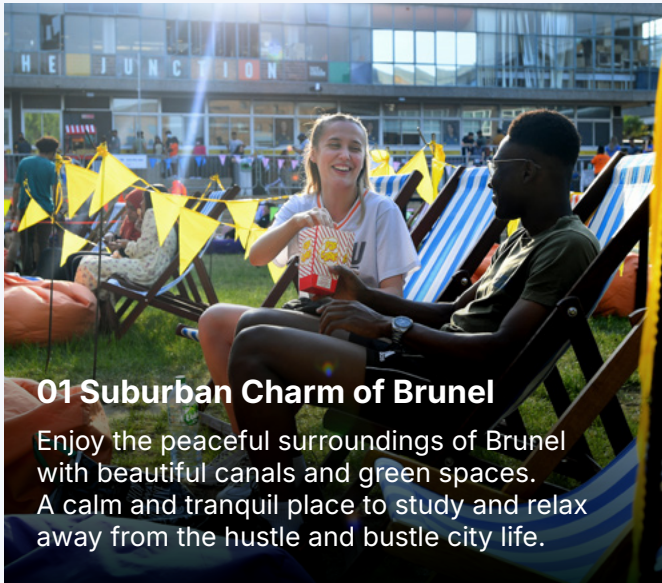

Enjoy the peaceful surroundings of Brunel with beautiful canals and green spaces. A calm and tranquil place to study and relax away from the hustle and bustle city life.



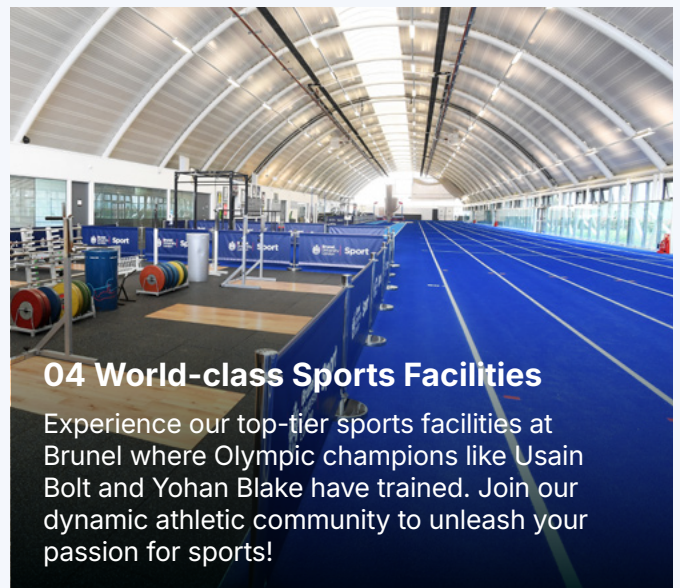
02 London Business Hub

London's riversides and tall buildings are amazing to see. Experience the busy city life, where everything is modern and stylish in this part of London.



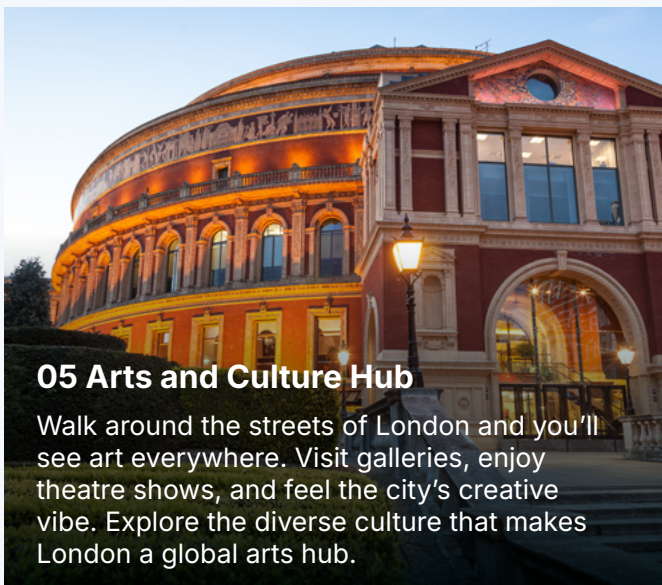
03 Easy Travel
