INTERNATIONALISATION IN STUDENT HOSTEL

- Some designated Non-local/ International Floor/ Wing in hostels
- Promote interactions among exchange students, non-local and local students
- Hostel is a learning platform for all students to learn adaptability, independence, communication skills, social skills, problem solving, sense of belonging, etc.
- Students may choose local or non-local residents to be their roommate(s) based on their personal choices; roommate assignments with local/non-local students are made by mutual pairing requests.

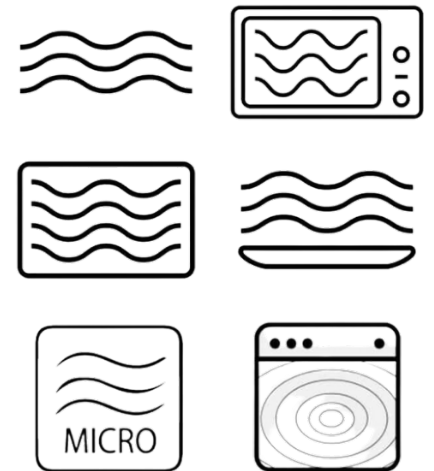
- Metal bowls

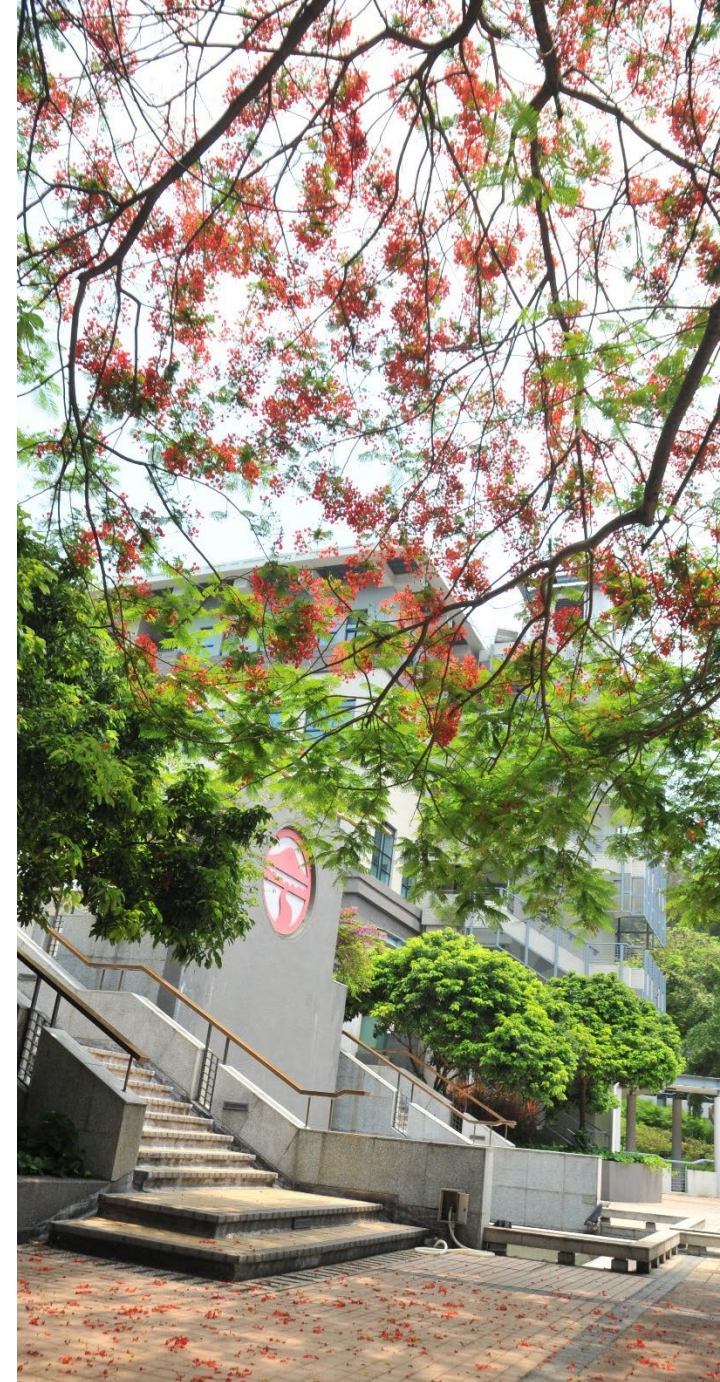
- Introduce peers with similar interests in language learning to you

CROSS-CULTURAL INTEGRATION

Encourage non-local students' engagement in hostel and campus life

- Encourage and facilitate social networking between local and non-local students especially in hostels, such as encourage local students to invite their non-local roommate for a family visit for better understanding of local cultural.
- To strengthen the sense of belonging of non-local students towards the University, they are encourage to contribute to the University or take up roles in the committee of student societies or join the University sports teams.

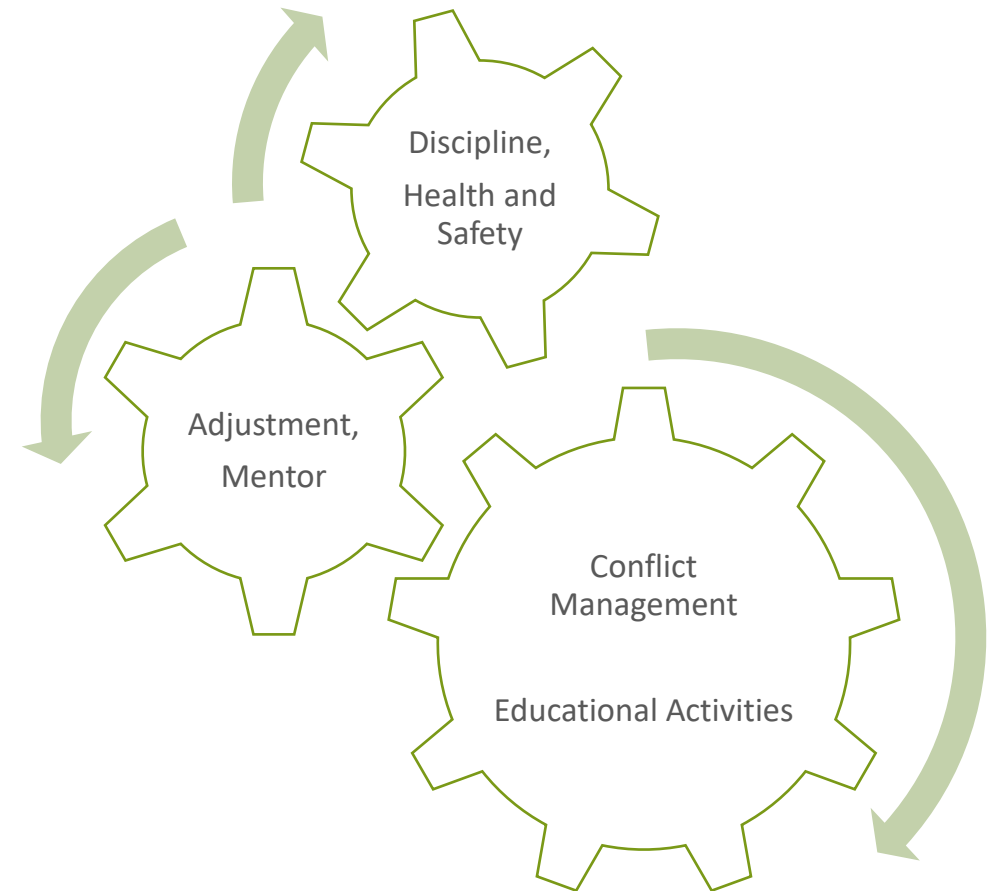

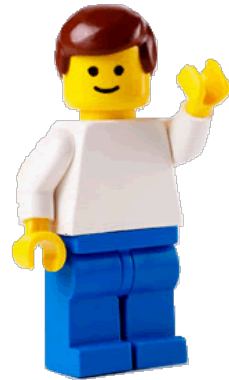

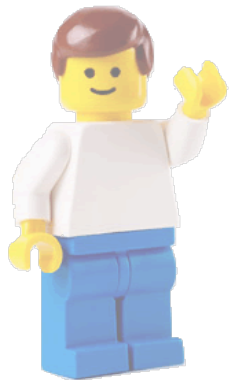
PLEASE ATTEND THE WELCOMING ACTIVITIES FOR NEW HOSTEL RESIDENTS
