SDU at a Glance

1. Long history

Shandong University (SDU) is one of the initiative universities of modern Chinese higher education. Its main body, Shandong Imperial College (Shandong Da Xue Tang), established in 1901, was the second national university in China. It was also the first university to be established and run in accordance with a chartered constitution.



2. Academic excellence

Shandong University is one of the top-ranked universities in China. According to the latest Essential Science Indicators (ESI) data, Shandong University has 5 disciplines among the top 1‰ in the world, namely chemistry, engineering, clinical medicine, materials science, and pharmacology and toxicology, and 19 disciplines among the top 1%. At present, Shandong University has 12 state scientific research platforms, 4 key social science research bases approved by the Ministry of Education and a large number of provincial scientific research centers.



3. Multicultural campus and beautiful scenery

Shandong University endeavors to foster a vibrant community with a breadth of experience across national boundaries, cultural backgrounds, academic interests, and more. By travelling to different campuses, students can enjoy different landscapes, such as natural springs in Jinan, swimming in the sea at Qingdao and Weihai, and climbing Mount Lao in Qingdao, where you can find the co-existence of Taoism and Buddhism. Shandong Province, the very home of Shandong University, is the birthplace of Confucius, where China's traditional culture and long-established values are on full display.

APPLICATION

Number of Exchange Students

- Per the student exchange agreement between two universities
 - Exchange programs are open to undergraduates and graduate students.
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Exchange Period

- One or two semesters
 - Enrollment is possible in the spring semester or fall semester
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Entry Requirement

There is no requirement for studying Chinese language.

For academic courses, students must meet the following requirements:

1. GPA: 70/100, 2.3/4.0
2. Year of study
 - At the undergraduate level, applicants should have completed the equivalent of at least one year of full-time study in the program in which they are enrolled at their home university.
 - At the graduate level, applicants should have completed at least the first semester of the master's or doctoral program in which they are enrolled at their home university.
3. Applicants must be enrolled as regular students in a partner university and not have graduated from their home universities before completing the mobility period at SDU.
4. Language proficiency

- Chinese-taught academic courses: HSK 4 and above

Applicants will be exempt from providing Chinese proficiency test results if one of the following criteria is met:

- Native Chinese speakers
- Applicants who have obtained their highest degree in an institution where the primary language of instruction is Chinese. Then official proof must be submitted.

- English-taught academic courses: No proof of English proficiency is required, but it is strongly recommended for students to reach the level of TOEFL iBT 80/IELTS 6.

Applicants will be exempt from demonstrating English proficiency if one of the following criteria is met:

- Native English speakers
- Applicants who have obtained their highest degree in an institution where the primary language of instruction is English. Then official proof must be submitted.

Nomination

Nomination link will be sent to coordinators via email.

Deadline: **May 30** for Sep enrollment, **November 30** for Feb enrollment

Application Period

Exchange students should apply through SDU online application system.

- Feb enrollment: September 1 to November 30
- Sep enrollment: March 1 to May 30

Online Application

 1. Create an account: click "Register" to register with your email and nationality
 2. Activate the account.

3. Log into the application system. Select “Exchange Students,” and you will see a list of programs. Choose the one that suits you most considering duration and instruction language, and then start the application.

Notes:

All the exchange programs in the application system are listed under the College of International Education. Admission Office will forward the applicants' materials to a relevant school/college according to the information given in the nomination form, transcript, and study plan for further approval.

4. Fill in the application form.
5. Upload the following documents:
 - Passport-sized photo
 - Information page of your passport (including photo, name, date of birth, place of birth, county of citizenship)
 - Official up-to-date transcripts in English/Chinese issued by your home university
 - Nomination letter from the exchange coordinator in English/Chinese
 - Personal Statement including study plan in English/Chinese

Language of Instruction

Course Load

- Undergraduates

Normally 3 to 5 courses per semester (2 or 3 credits per course)

- Graduates

Minimum study load is 1 postgraduate course or carrying out research with the consent of a SDU supervisor.

- Semester 1 (Sep enrollment): mid-to-late June
- Semester 2 (Feb enrollment): mid-to-late December

The second week of each semester

Academic Transcript

- Official transcripts are usually issued in late-March for fall semester and late September for spring semester.
- Office for Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan Affairs will post official English and Chinese transcripts to home universities.

Tuition Fee

The tuition fee of Shandong University will be waived for exchange students conforming with the exchange agreements. Students shall pay tuition fees to their home university.
