Q: Do you need to attend class when the no. 8 typhoon signal is in force?

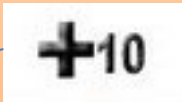

All classes will be cancelled. Avoid staying outdoor. Return home (hostel) as soon as possible if conditions so permit.

Q: Do you need to attend class when the red rainstorm signal is issued?

Answer: YES

★ Do you know...

- Rain could be particularly heavy and persistent from May to September.
- Warning signals:

➤ Amber 

➤ Red 

➤ Black 

Stay indoors or take shelter in a safe place until the heavy rain has passed. Classes will be cancelled. Students who are already in class should stay where they are unless it is dangerous to do so.

Q: What is the name of these cards?

Answer: (B) Octopus Card

★ **Do you know...**

- It is a stored value electronic card widely used in Hong Kong for:
 - public transport (Railways, bus, green mini bus, etc.)
 - purchases in convenience stores, fast food shops, supermarket
 - vending machine
- Place the Octopus Card over a reader, and the correct amount is deducted automatically from the stored value

★ **Do you know...**

Q: What are the differences between Green & Red minibuses?



Answer:

Green Minibus

- > Fixed stops & routes
- > Accepts Octopus Card



Do you know...

46 at the entrance of Lingnan (from Fu Tai -- to Tuen Mun Town Centre)



Red Minibus

- > Unfixed stops & routes
- > Not every route accepts Octopus Card



Do you know...

At the entrance of Lingnan (from Yuen Long -- to Mongkok & Jordan)

Q: There are 3 different colours of taxi in HK, what are they?

Answer:

Red – Urban Taxi



Green – New Territories



Blue – Lantau Taxi



Do you know...

- Operated by a meter, can request for receipt
- Seat belt required
- Only few of them accepts Octopus Card; Credit Cards not acceptable
- Cannot stop (pick-up / drop off) in areas that marked double yellow lines

Q: Name the nearest shopping centre from Lingnan?

Answer:

**Fu Tai Shopping Centre
(5-10 minutes walk from Lingnan)**



Do you know...

- **There are supermarket, Chinese restaurant, fast food restaurant, convenience store and post office**

Q: What is the Emergency number in Hong Kong?

Answer: (C) 999



Do you know...

- **Lost of Passport**
 - **Report to the nearest police station**
(call Police Hotline 2527-7177 for nearest police station)
 - **Contact your Consulate to have your passport replaced**

Passport and Student Visa

- Proof of identity
- Report Lost: report to the **Police**, the **Consulate General** of your home country and **OGE** immediately.
- Student visa: a **multi entry visa**
- If you will travel outside HK, you are required to notify us by completing a **notification form before departure** (<https://www.ln.edu.hk/oge/download/notification-to-OGE.doc>)



Conditions for a Person Holding Student Visa Status

- It is clearly stipulated by the Immigration Department of Hong Kong that any person entering Hong Kong as a student shall be subject to the following conditions of stay that:
 - (a) he/she shall become a student only at a specified school, university or other educational institution and undertake such course of study as may be approved by the Director of Immigration; and
 - (b) he/she shall not (i) take any employment, whether paid or unpaid; or (ii) establish or join in any business.

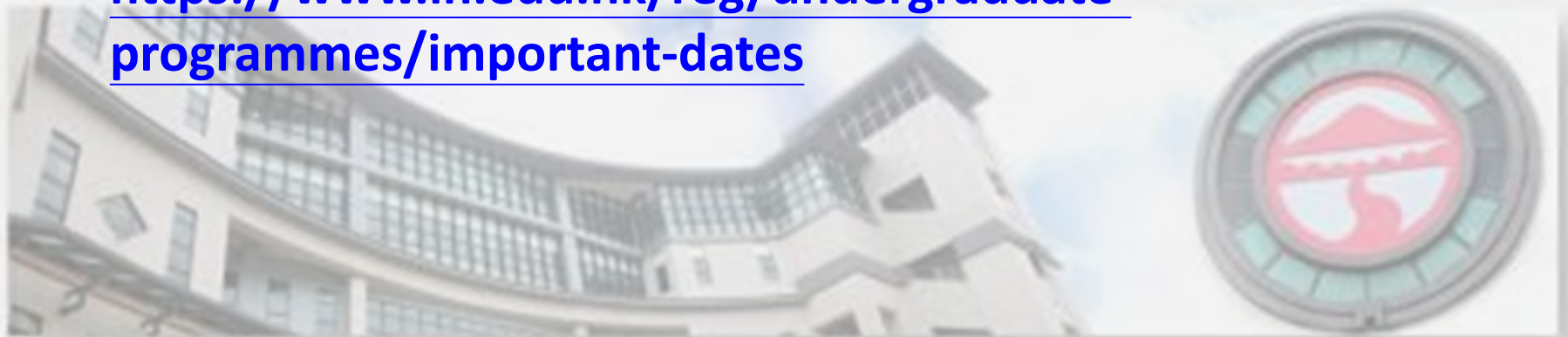
Add and Drop Period
