Programme Highlights:	- Each module is a 6-week intensive programme with courses in the field of International Business. 4 modules available from mid-May till mid-August. - Courses lectured 5 days a week, 3 hours a day. - To experience the Finnish summer while studying in an international environment

Programme Fee:	Free of charge programme with an estimated housing fee* at EUR500-700 (Around HK\$4,500-5,500) <i>*Subject to which 2 modules and the type of apartments that you choose</i> Upon successful completion of the programme, Lingnan will provide a programme fee subsidy of HK\$1,000.

	Remarks: 1. Tuition and housing fees are included. 2. Upon successful admission by Aalto, exchange students are recommended to apply for their accommodation directly from the Mikkeli District Student Housing Ltd at https://mikalof.fi/en/. 3. Rent per month will be approximately EUR 335 for a shared apartment and approximately EUR 480 for a single apartment (the rent includes furniture, electricity, water, Internet, use of laundry and sauna). The renting period usually starts either 1st or 16th of the month and ends either 15th or last day of the month. A monthly budget for exchange students would be approximately EUR 700-900 (around HK\$6,400-8,200) per month (including accommodation, living expenses, course materials and personal expenses). 4. On top of housing fee, you have to pay for visa, insurance, meals & other miscellaneous items.
Additional Requirements:	- English is the language of instruction, it is essential that all participants are prepared to understand rapid, idiomatic English as spoken in lectures and group discussions. Students also are expected to be able to read English with ease and to express their thoughts clearly in spoken and written English. - The expected level of English proficiency is equivalent to IELTS 6.5 (total), TOEFL 87 (total) or CEFR B2. A letter from Lingnan faculty certifying English proficiency is also accepted. - No previous in-person exchange experience of Summer International Exchange Programmes arranged by OGE. - Exchange Experience: Students who have participated or will participate in semester-long/winter student exchange programmes under OGE are welcome to apply for this programme!
Availability of Financial Subsidy:	- Means-tested Schemes for EDB Subsidy for local students of up to HK\$18,000 - Air ticket sponsorship (available to students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have never received the sponsorship) - Students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have participated in OGE semester-long/short-term student exchange programmes will be considered for airfare allowance.
