Programme Highlights:	- A four-week program with a task-based language study component and a thematic, omnibus component that focuses on various aspects of Japan. - Participants will be taking a set of courses with lectures in class as well as theme related fieldwork and cultural activities, allowing you to be introduced and exposed to Japanese culture and enhance the practical ability of the Japanese language you have learned so far.
Course List:	- Japanese Language Module and Japan Studies Module - Check if you fulfill course pre-requisites, if any, and have sufficient prior knowledge for the academic level of the course(s) (e.g. bachelor or master level).
Programme Fee:	JPY374,700 (Around HK\$ 18,600) Upon successful completion of the programme, Lingnan will provide a programme fee subsidy of HK\$4,000. Remarks: 1. Tuition, on-campus dormitory fees, administration charge, and a textbook are included. 2. Participants will be arranged to stay at ICU on-campus dormitory: rooms will be shared by 2 students with beds, desks and air conditioning in each room. Restrooms, kitchen, shower facilities to be shared. 3. Programme fee is subject to fluctuation of exchange rate and final confirmation by OGE. 4. On top of programme fee, you have to pay for visa, insurance, meals & other miscellaneous items.
Additional Requirements:	- CGPA preferably with 3.0 or above as of Term 1, 2025-26 - A minimum Japanese language level of low intermediate (CEFR A2/ JLPT N4/ ICU J4 level) is required, no beginners will be accepted - Good command of English. TOEFL 79 / IELTS 6.0 is recommended.

	- No previous in-person Summer International Exchange Programmes arranged by OGE. - Students who have participated or will participate in semester-long/winter student exchange programmes under OGE are welcome to apply for this programme!
Availability of Financial Subsidy:	- Means-tested Schemes for EDB Subsidy for local students of up to HK\$9,000 - Air ticket sponsorship (available to students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have never received the sponsorship) - Students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have participated in OGE semester-long/short-term student exchange programmes will be considered for airfare allowance.
