Programme Name:	Study & Travel in Japan - Summer Session 2026
Programme Period:	Flexible from 16 May to 25 July
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Credit Load:	4 Lingnan credits (One session – 2 week)
Programme Highlights:	- A two-week program offers a wide range of courses on the topics of language, business, culture, IT, history and politics. - Participants can also join the optional Hakuba Trip (4 days 3 nights) at the end of each session (JYP 60,000).

Programme Fee:	JPY335,000 (Around HK\$ 16,700) [excluding Hakuba trip] Upon successful completion of the programme, Lingnan will provide a programme subsidy of HK\$1,000. <i>*If you wish to join the Hakuba Trip, there will be an extra JPY 60,000 (around HK\$ 3,000)</i> Remarks: 1. Tuition, single room - off campus accommodation fees, cultural activities (Kimono Wearing, Tea Ceremony, Calligraphy, Scavenger Hunt), and textbook are included. 2. Programme fee is subject to fluctuation of exchange rate and final confirmation by OGE. 3. On top of programme fee, you have to pay for visa, insurance, meals & other miscellaneous items.
Additional Requirements:	- No previous in-person overseas Summer International Exchange Programmes arranged by OGE. - Exchange Experience: Students who have participated or will participate in semester-long/winter student exchange programmes under OGE are welcome to apply for this programme!
Availability of Financial	- Means-tested Schemes for EDB Subsidy for local students of up to HK\$9,000

Subsidy:	- Air ticket sponsorship (available to students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have never received the sponsorship) - Students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have participated in OGE semester-long/short-term student exchange programmes will be considered for airfare allowance.
