Programme Highlights:	- A four-week programme designed to teach the language within its academic, cultural and social context, so that students deepen their knowledge of Germany, whilst simultaneously developing their language skills. - Language courses will be supplemented by a variety of activities such as lectures, films and excursions to points of local cultural significance. Tutors shall also participate in the extra-curricular activities and are available for consultation throughout.
Course List:	You will be assigned to different levels of German language course according to the results of an online placement test, distributed by e-mail during July. Check if you fulfill course pre-requisites, if any, and have sufficient prior knowledge for the academic level of the course(s) (e.g. bachelor or master level). <i>*Please refer to here for course details.</i>
Programme Fee:	EUR1,327 (Around: HK\$12,100) Upon successful completion of the programme, Lingnan will provide a programme fee subsidy of HK\$1,000. Remarks: 1. Registration, tuition, accommodation, cultural program, course materials and excursions fees are included. 2. Optional Workshop Theater or Phonetic (choose one only) with additional cost at EUR75 (around HK\$700). 3. Programme fee is subject to fluctuation of exchange rate and final confirmation by OGE. 4. On top of programme fee, you have to pay for visa, insurance, meals & other miscellaneous items.

Additional Requirement:	- No previous in-person overseas Summer International Exchange Programmes arranged by OGE. - Exchange Experience: Students who have participated or will participate in semester-long/winter student exchange programmes under OGE are welcome to apply for this programme!
Availability of Financial Subsidy:	- Means-tested Schemes for EDB Subsidy for local students of up to HK\$14,000 - Air ticket sponsorship (available to students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have never received the sponsorship) - Students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have participated in OGE semester-long/short-term student exchange programmes will be considered for airfare allowance.
