Credit Load:	Up to 2 courses at HYU (up to 6 Lingnan credits)
Programme Highlights:	- A four-week programme with over 100 courses in different fields will be offered. The courses will motivate students to expand their views of the world by experiencing a new way of learning. - Students can experience Korean culture and join a variety of activities outside the classroom. - Free Club Activities (22 types, After class & Weekends) at HYU and Group Activities (Cultural excursions, Company visit, etc) at JNU
Course List:	You should take 2 courses (up to 6 Lingnan credits) at HYU. Check if you fulfill course pre-requisites, if any, and have <u>sufficient prior knowledge</u> for the academic level of the course(s) (e.g. Korean Language level). <i>*Please refer to here for course details.</i>
Programme Fee:	KRW2,700,000 (Around HK\$ 14,500) Upon successful completion of the programme, Lingnan will provide a programme fee subsidy of HK\$4,000. Remarks: 1. Application, tuition, activity and on-campus accommodation fees as well as flight from Seoul to Jeju are included. *Flight from hometown to Seoul, and flight from Jeju to hometown are not included. * 2. Programme fee is subject to fluctuation of exchange rate and final confirmation by OGE. 3. On top of programme fee, you have to pay for visa, insurance, meals & other miscellaneous items.

Additional Requirement:	- No previous in-person Summer International Exchange Programmes arranged by OGE. - Exchange Experience: Students who have participated or will participate in semester-long/winter student exchange programmes under OGE are welcome to apply for this programme!
Availability of Financial Subsidy:	- Schemes for EDB Subsidy for local students of up to HK\$9,000 - Air ticket sponsorship (available to students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have never received the sponsorship) - Students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have participated in OGE semester-long/short-term student exchange programmes will be considered for airfare allowance.
