Programme Fee:	KRW2,540,000 (Around HK\$ 13,500) Upon successful completion of the programme, Lingnan will provide a programme fee subsidy of HK\$4,000. Remarks: 1. Application, tuition and accommodation (double room) fees are included. 2. Programme fee is subject to fluctuation of exchange rate and final confirmation by OGE. 3. On top of programme fee, you have to pay for visa, insurance, meals & other miscellaneous items.
Additional Requirement:	- No previous in-person Summer International Exchange Programmes arranged by OGE. - Exchange Experience: Students who have participated or will participate in semester-long/winter student exchange programmes under OGE are welcome to apply for this programme!
Availability of Financial Subsidy:	- Schemes for EDB Subsidy for local students of up to HK\$9,000 - Air ticket sponsorship (available to students enrolled in UGC-funded programmes who have not participated or will not participate in OGE semester-long/short-term student exchange programmes)
