Availability of Financial aid & Subsidy:	- Non-means-tested Mainland Experience Scheme for Post-secondary Students (Non-means-tested MES) is made available to local or non-local students to go on exchange in the Mainland China - o Subsidy of Non-means-tested MES up to HK\$1,950 - o Applicants are eligible for assistance under Non-means-tested MES <u>ONCE</u> throughout their study in programmes at the same level of study in Hong Kong, irrespective of the amount of subsidy received.
Additional Information:	- Exchange Experience: Students who have participated or will participate in semester-long/short-term student exchange programmes under OGE are welcome to apply for this programme.

Students who withdraw from the programme after the offer is confirmed or who cannot

	complete the programme satisfactorily/pass all required assessments may result in the following: a) forfeiting the full programme fee or the HK\$1,000 deposit b) paying back any fees which are being sponsored by Lingnan or the host institution c) leading to negative impacts on future exchange and/or exchange scholarship applications - OGE reserves the final right in the selection of students for Summer Programmes 2026.
