All the course related work will be done during the module and there are no separate exam periods. - To experience the Finnish summer while studying in an international environment

Tuition fees of 6 LU credits (12 ECTS) are included. 2. Upon successful admission by Aalto, exchange students are recommended to apply for their accommodation directly from the Mikkeli District Student Housing Ltd here.

	<p>3. Rent varies from EUR 280-335 for a shared apartment and approximately EUR 430 for a single apartment (the rent includes furniture, electricity, water, Internet, use of laundry and sauna). A monthly budget for exchange students would be approximately EUR 500-800 (around HKD4,100-6,600) per month (including accommodation, living expenses, course materials and personal expenses).</p> <p>4. On top of accommodation fees, students have to pay for visa (if needed), insurance, meals & other miscellaneous items.</p>
Additional Requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - English is the language of instruction, it is essential that all participants are prepared to understand rapid, idiomatic English as spoken in lectures and group discussions. Students also are expected to be able to read English with ease and to express their thoughts clearly in spoken and written English. - The expected level of English proficiency is equivalent to IELTS 6.5 (total), TOEFL 87 (total) or CEFR B2. A letter from Lingnan faculty certifying English proficiency is also accepted.
