ETHICAL TERMS	
Algorithmic Bias	When AI systems produce unfair outcomes due to biased training data
Transparency	Clearly disclosing when and how AI tools are used in work
Data Privacy	Protecting personal and sensitive information when using AI tools
Human-in-the-Loop	Keeping human oversight and decision-making in AI-assisted processes

Divergent Thinking

Generating many different ideas and possibilities (AI excels here)

Convergent Thinking

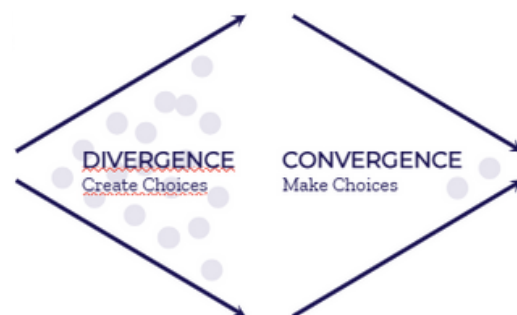
Narrowing down to the best ideas and solutions (Human judgment crucial)

Prototyping

Creating early versions of ideas to test and refine (AI can accelerate)

Stakeholder Alignment

Ensuring solutions meet the needs of all involved parties (Human empathy essential)
