

Minor in English

The Department of English offers the Minor in English.

Students whose Major is in any programmes other than BA (Hons) Contemporary English Studies / BA (Hons) English Studies may qualify for a Minor in English after successful completion of 15 credits of courses as detailed below.

Required Courses (6 credits)

- 1) ENG2101 Introduction to the Study of Language (titled as Introduction to Language in 2023-24 or before)
or
ENG2103 Introduction to English Grammar (deleted from 2020-21)
- 2) ENG2106 Introduction to Literature I (titled as Literary Analysis I in 2023-24 or before)
or
ENG2107 Introduction to Literature II (titled as Literary Analysis II in 2023-24 or before)

Elective Courses (9 credits)

Three electives chosen from the courses offered by the Department of English, excluding those offered as Core Curriculum courses.

Note: Students who have already taken ENG2103 Introduction to English Grammar do not need to take ENG2101 Introduction to the Study of Language (titled as Introduction to Language in 2023-24 or before).
