## Terms of Reference

- a) To formulate University-wide research policy, and to promote a research culture whereby Faculties and non-Faculty research units together with their academic staff are accountable for research targets and performance expected of them.
- b) To oversee the work of the research units<sup>1</sup> and to receive annual reports from those units<sup>1</sup>.
- c) To endorse the appointment of Affiliate Fellows/Centre Fellows and Advisory Board Members of the research units<sup>1</sup>.
- d) To provide the One-line RC Allocation to Faculty Research and Postgraduate Studies Committees for specific internal research funds.
- e) To endorse recommendations from the Sub-Committee on Research Ethics and Safety.
- f) To endorse allocations of research funds under the Research Committee<sup>2</sup>.
- g) To monitor the progress of research projects with funds provided from the Research Committee<sup>2</sup>.
- h) To advise on the strategies and policies supporting Knowledge Transfer.
- i) To deal with other matters related to research and the research units<sup>1</sup> as deemed appropriate by the Research Committee.
