Biography

Tatiana lakovleva is an esteemed Professor of Entrepreneurship at Stavanger Business School, Norway, with a Ph.D. in Entrepreneurship from Bode Graduate School of Business (2008). Her research primarily focuses on the role of universities in regional development, entrepreneurial intentions, gender in entrepreneurship, social responsibility in business development, and the impact of digitalization on societal transformations. She has authored three influential books: the first in 2019 on inclusive entrepreneurship practices in digital health across seven countries, the second in 2022 discussing the role of entrepreneurial universities in European regional development, and the third forthcoming in 2024 on user involvement in innovation practices in digital health.

Her scholarly contributions, surpassing 55 international peer-reviewed publications, have found homes in eminent journals like Entrepreneurship Theory and Practice, Entrepreneurship and Regional Development, Journal of Small Business and Enterprise Development, Education+Training, Journal of Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Journal of Small Business and Entrepreneurship, International Journal of Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management, International Journal of Innovation and Regional Development.. Apart from being a Visiting Scholar at San Diego State University, Tatiana has been recognized with numerous awards, including the Top Research Award for Young Female Researchers. She pioneered a Master of Science program in innovation and entrepreneurship at the University of Stavanger and has personally mentored 30+ student entrepreneurial teams. Currently, she helms an international project on responsible entrepreneurship in digital health and has raised significant funding to support the University of Stavanger Centre for Innovation Research's vision.
