

Suggested Study Plan for First-Year BSocSc Students (Year 2 Entry under All Majors)

The normal study load of a full-time first year student should be 15 in a term and the maximum study load should be **30 credits in an academic year**. BSocSc students are advised to enroll in the following 10 courses (30 credits) in your first year of studies:
