Important Notes:

- Senior-Year (Year 3) entry students admitted in AY2026-27 should adhere to the Programme Structure of AY2024-25.

- Students are required to take **60 credits** (i.e. **20 courses**) to fulfil the Major graduation requirement.
- The normal study load of a second year or above full-time student in a term should be in the range of 15-18 credits and the maximum study load in an academic year should be 33 credits.
- Subject to the course places, the Registry may pre-assign some courses in the student's study plan. **It is important not to change these pre-assigned courses.** For the remaining courses that students wish to take, they should manually enter the respective course codes into their study plan. If the course place is full, students may not receive any pre-assigned courses in the study plan and will need to manually input the course codes for all the courses they intend to take.
- Please ensure that the inputted courses are offered in the corresponding term. The course offering list is available in the Course Registration system or on the Registry's website.
