1 Moodle

Online learning materials:

Moodle is the main online platform that your teacher uses to upload and store learning materials (such as videos and audios), please access <u>regularly</u> to keep abreast of the latest updates posted by your course teacher.

Communicating with your teachers:

Apart from email, your teachers may communicate with you in Moodle. Please sign in to Moodle <u>regularly</u> and click the <u>envelop icon</u> on the top right-hand corner to check messages.
